## 3.1 INSTALLATION

- A. Install in accordance with manufacturer's instructions.
- B. Decking Installation Method: [Visible screws.] [Hidden clips.]
- C. [Railing] [Handrail] [Steps] [and] [Trim] Installation Method: Face screws.
- D. Place decking to span two or more supports.
- E. Stagger decking end joints in adjacent rows.

- F. Anchor decking to supports.
- G. Install [railings] [handrails] [steps] [and] [trim] using face screw method.
